

ASTERISM KIDS

The Kids is a small triangle of stars near Capella in the constellation Auriga formed by the stars Almaaz, Hoedus I and Hoedus II.

One of the most ancient legends had Auriga as a goatherd and patron of shepherds. The brilliant golden yellow Capella was known as “The She-Goat Star”. The nearby triangle of fainter stars are her three kids.

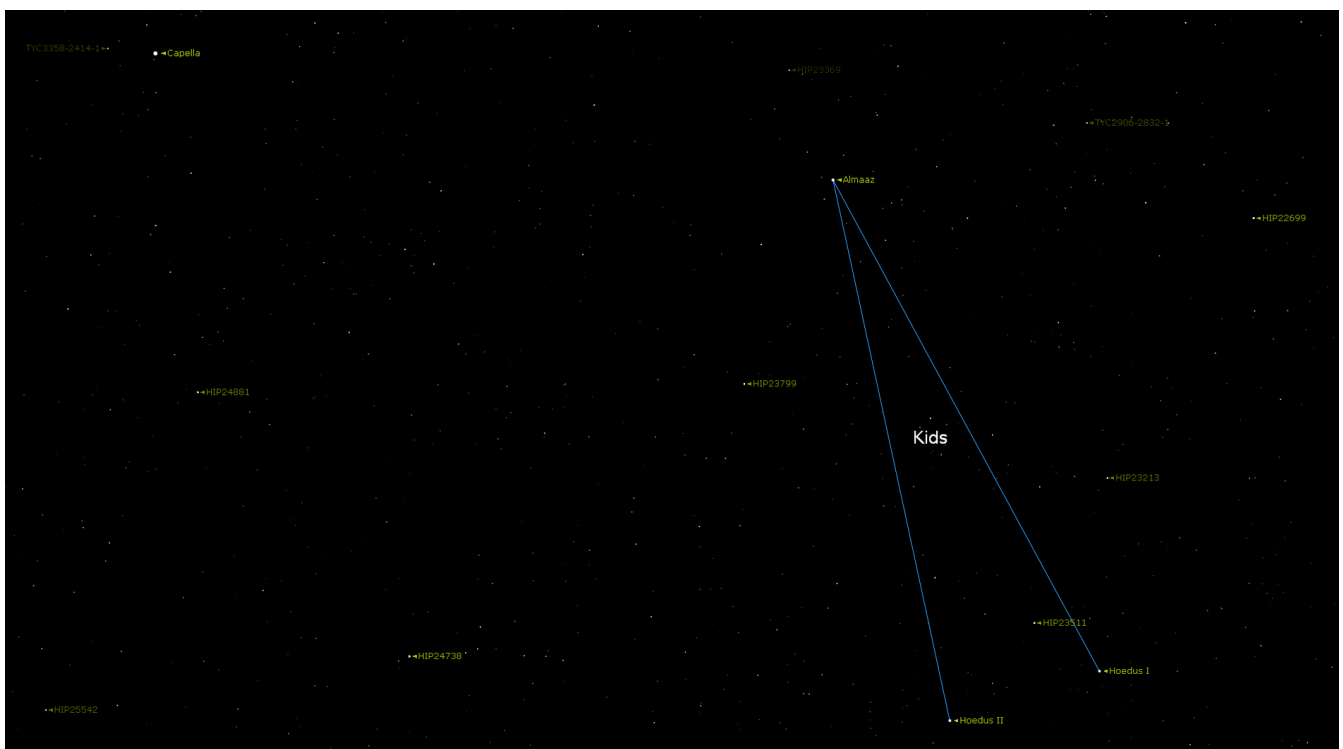
The brightest of the three stars is Almaaz, which is arabic for “He-Goat”. Almaaz is a yellow-white supergiant that will expire someday in a cataclysmic explosion called a Supernova.

The other two dimmer stars are called the Headi, which is latin for the kids.

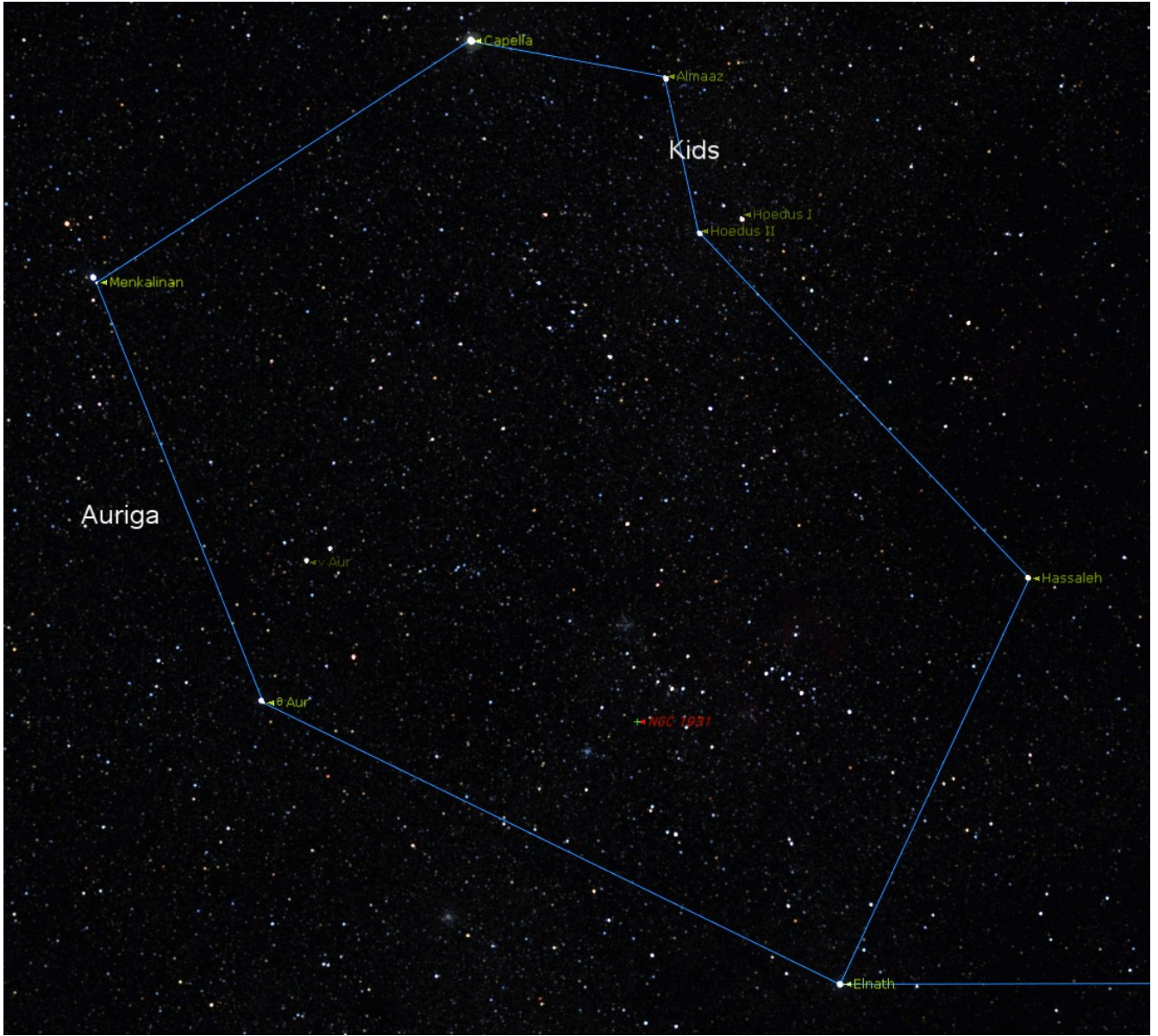
Asterism - An asterism is a distinctive pattern of stars or a distinctive group of stars in the sky.

Constellation - A grouping of stars that make an imaginary picture in the sky. There are 88 constellations.

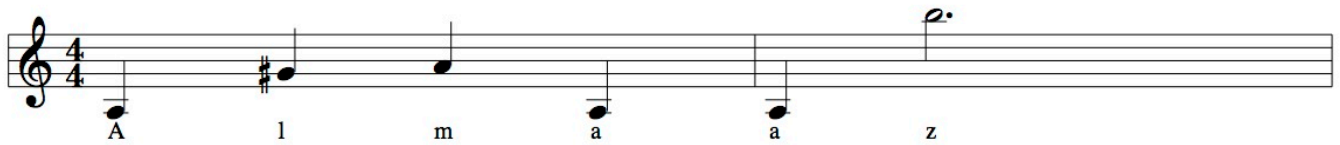
